IMPORTANT-READ CAREFULLY: This MICROSHOPDB.COM End-User License Agreement ("EULA") is a legal agreement between you (either an individual or a single entity or both) and MICROSHOPDB.COM for the software product identified above, which includes computer software and may include associated media, printed materials, and "online" or electronic documentation ("SOFTWARE PRODUCT"). By installing, copying, or otherwise using the SOFTWARE PRODUCT, you agree to be bound by the terms of this EULA. If you do not agree to the terms of this EULA, do not install, copy, or use the SOFTWARE PRODUCT.

SOFTWARE PRODUCT LICENSE

The SOFTWARE PRODUCT is protected by copyright laws and international copyright treaties, as well as other intellectual property laws and treaties. The SOFTWARE PRODUCT is licensed, not sold.

1. GRANT OF LICENSE.

1.1. Subject to the terms of this EULA, MICROSHOPDB.COM grants to you a personal, nonexclusive license to make and use a limited number of copies of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT to be installed on a limited number of CPUs only residing on your premises, provided that

1.1.1. you have a valid MICROSHOPDB.COM license and

1.1.2. each copy shall be a true and complete copy, including all copyright and trademark notices, and shall be accompanied by a copy of this EULA. Please be advised that the SOFTWARE PRODUCT will not de-encapsulate unless the initial installation is performed on a CPU running MICROSHOPDB.COM Products.

1.2. Redistributable Code. Portions of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT are designated as "Redistributable Code." The Redistributable Code consists of:

1.2.1. the portions of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT designated by MICROSHOPDB.COM as Text Output Files; and

1.2.2. the output created through use of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT. Contact MICROSHOPDB.COM for the applicable royalties due and other licensing terms for all other uses and/or distribution of the Redistributable Code outside the scope of this Section. You may use, copy and redistribute the Redistributable Code provided that

1.2.2.1. you use, and require that your end-user customers use, the Redistributable Code only on computers or workstations for which a valid Client Access License for MICROSHOPDB.COM Product of the same or later version has been obtained;

- 1.2.2.2. you distribute all or any part of the Redistributable Code only as part of or in conjunction with a Setup Program created by you;
- 1.2.2.3. your Setup Program, and any software programs installed by execution of your Setup Program, are distributed on an "AS-IS" basis;
- 1.2.2.4. you only permit further redistribution of the Redistributable Code by your end-user customers under the same restrictions imposed on you under the provisions of Section 1.2.2.2;
- 1.2.2.5. you do not use the MICROSHOPDB.COM name, logo, or trademarks to market your Setup Program or any software programs installed by execution of your Setup Program;
- 1.2.2.6. you do not use the MICROSHOP name, logo, or trademarks to market your Setup Program or any software programs installed by execution of your Setup Program;
- 1.2.2.7. you include a valid copyright notice with your Setup Program; and
- 1.2.2.8. you agree to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend MICROSHOPDB.COM from and against any claims or lawsuits, including attorneys' fees, that arise or result from the use or distribution of your Setup Program and any software programs installed by execution of your Setup Program.

1.3. Due to the nature of software and its continued use, we reserve the right to make changes to your Agreement at any time, without notice, therefore, you hereby agree that this Agreement is in force until superseded by a more recent version, the most up to date version being available for download from MICROSHOPDB.COM. In any disputes, we will always refer to the latest agreement in force. The latest version can be identified by its revision number and/or date last amended, noted at the bottom of the Agreement.

2. DESCRIPTION OF OTHER RIGHTS AND LIMITATIONS.

- 2.1. Limitations on Reverse Engineering, Decompilation and Disassembly. You may not reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the SOFTWARE PRODUCT, except and only to the extent that such activity is expressly permitted by applicable law notwithstanding this limitation.
- 2.2. Separation of Components. The SOFTWARE PRODUCT is licensed as a single product. Its component parts may not be separated for use on more than one computer.
- 2.3. Support Services. MICROSHOPDB.COM may provide you with support services related to the SOFTWARE PRODUCT ("Support Services"). Use of Support Services is governed by MICROSHOPDB.COM's policies and programs described in the user manual, in "online" documentation, and/or in other MICROSHOPDB.COM-provided materials. - 2.4. Rental. You may not rent, lease, lend or otherwise allow any person to access to the SOFTWARE PRODUCT that are not specified in your agreement. This would include IT Professionals, Accountants, Solicitors or other person not expressly identified in your

- 2.7. Termination. Without prejudice to any other rights, MICROSHOPDB.COM may terminate this EULA if you fail to comply with the terms and conditions of this EULA. In such event, you must destroy all copies of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT and all of its component parts.
- 2.8. Annual Re-license. Annually, or at intervals set by MicroShopDB.com, the software will require relicensing. This is carried out at no charge and will be carried out via a remote session. It will be necessary to make remote access to your hardware available in order to carry out the re-license routine.

3. UPGRADES & UPDATES.

3.1. Definition of terms clarified:

3.1.1.
